## **Schedule of Classes**

## **LLANCARFAN VILLAGE SHOW**

**Saturday 22nd August 2026**

### **SECTION 1 – FLOWERS**

- Class 1 : A single rose judged for perfume
- Class 2 : Roses – a vase of 3 blooms
- Class 3 : Dahlia (any type) – 1 bloom in a vase
- Class 4 : 3 Pom Pom dahlias
- Class 5 : Vase of dahlias - mixed
- Class 6 : Hydrangea – 1 bloom in a vase
- Class 7 : Floating flower heads or leaves in a bowl no bigger than 8"/20 cm diameter
- Class 8 : Mixed flowers and foliage in a vase
- Class 9 : A vase of herbs – one or more cultivars
- Class 10 : 6 Sweet Peas

### **SECTION 2 – POT PLANTS**

- Class 11 : Pot plant – foliage – pot no bigger than 10"/25.4 cm diameter
- Class 12 : Pot plant – flowering and not a geranium – pot no bigger than 10"/25.4 cm diameter
- Class 13 : Geranium – pot no bigger than 10"/25.4 cm diameter
- Class 14 : Succulent(s)
- Class 15 : A pot of one grass

### **SECTION 3 – FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS – open to all**

- Class 16 : An arrangement suitable for a Ruby Wedding Anniversary
- Class 17 : An arrangement to include apples
- Class 18 : An arrangement in summer colours not exceeding 10" (25 cm) in width, depth or height
- Class 19 : An arrangement to depict 'Elegance'
- Class 20 : A tall arrangement to depict 'Fire'
- Class 21 : An arrangement to include 'School Memories'
- Class 22 : An arrangement depicting 'Teddy Bear's Picnic'
- Class 23 : A buttonhole suitable for a wedding

#### **SECTION 4 – FRUIT AND VEGETABLES**

- Class 24 : Any soft fruit – 5 pieces
- Class 25 : Any other fruit – 5 pieces
- Class 26 : 5 potatoes
- Class 27 : 6 Runner Beans
- Class 28 : 3 carrots – trimmed
- Class 29 : 6 tomatoes (not cherry varieties)
- Class 30 : 6 cherry tomatoes
- Class 31 : 3 courgettes – 4" to 6"/ 10 to 15 cm in length
- Class 32 : 5 onions
- Class 33 : 2 cucumbers
- Class 34 : From garden to kitchen – a display of produce in a trug/basket – 5 or more types of produce
- Class 35 : 'My ugliest fruit/vegetable'

#### **SECTION 5 – HOME BAKING, PRESERVES AND BEVERAGES**

- Class 36 : 6 sausage rolls – pastry to be home made
- Class 37 : A quiche – filling of choice – pastry to be home made
- Class 38 : 5 fruit scones
- Class 39 : Apple crumble – dish to be no larger than 10"
- Class 40 : 5 flavoured Welsh cakes
- Class 41 : Victoria sandwich
- Class 42 : Lemon drizzle cake to recipe

#### **Ingredients**

- 225g unsalted butter softened
- 225g caster sugar
- 4 eggs
- 225g self - raising flour
- 1 lemon zested

#### **For the drizzle topping**

- 1.5 lemons juiced
- 85g caster sugar

#### **Method**

**Step 1**

Heat the oven to 180C/160C fan/gas 4.

**Step 2**

Beat together the butter and caster sugar until pale and creamy, then add the eggs, one at a time, slowly mixing through.

**Step 3**

Sift in the self-raising flour, then add the lemon zest and mix until well combined.

**Step 4**

Line a 2 lb (about 14 x 24cm) loaf tin with greaseproof paper, then spoon in the mixture and level the top with a spoon.

**Step 5**

Bake for 45-50 mins until a thin skewer inserted into the centre of the cake comes out clean.

**Step 6**

While the cake is cooling in its tin, mix together the lemon juice and caster sugar to make the drizzle.

**Step 7**

Prick the warm cake all over with a skewer or fork, then pour over the drizzle – the juice will sink in and the sugar will form a lovely, crisp topping.

**Step 8**

Leave in the tin until completely cool, then remove.
